



Total ISCA 2025 Registrants Over Time





Main Symposium

3 Parallel Sessions: 135 papers including industry session papers
131 regular track, 4 industry track

The total number of supported students: 122

Main program presenters: 48 students (\$800 per student)

Workshop participants (paper presentation, etc.): 19 students (\$700 per student)

Others: 55 students (\$200 per student)
